



Cursillo de Cursillos Basic Guidelines

The Cursillo de Cursillos (CDC) will be conducted in English.

The CDC begins on a Thursday evening and concludes on a Sunday evening.

The CDC is a cloistered weekend; therefore, participants should make plans to attend the entire weekend.

The Cursillo de Cursillos is intended for those who are the leaders in the Diocesan/Archdiocesan Movement. Cursillistas, who, if they understood the purpose of the Movement and who are engaged in the process of discerning whether to make Cursillo their primary apostolate, should be invited to attend the Cursillo de Cursillos.

The CDC consists of 5 meditations and 15 rollos. Leaders are assigned to decurias just like on the 3-Day Weekend. This provides everyone an opportunity to share the message of each rollo. A question and answer session is provided after each rollo is given. Mass is celebrated on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

The host Diocesan Spiritual Advisor should inform and invite the local Bishop to attend the CDC if possible. If the Bishop is unable to attend the weekend, it would be good to either have him welcome the leaders at the start of the Cursillo de Cursillos or celebrate the closing Mass on Sunday.

The host Diocesan Secretariat/Movement is responsible for reimbursing the CDC team's travel expenses. The team usually consists of one Spiritual Advisor and 4 - 5 Cursillo Leaders.

The host Diocesan Secretariat/Movement is responsible for providing lodging and meals for all participants.

The host Diocesan Secretariat/Movement is responsible for providing name tags, folders, paper, pencils, etc. for the participants.

It is recommended that the Spanish language Cursillistas or other language Cursillo group handle the kitchen and other organizational duties so that ALL English language Cursillo Leaders can be active participants during the entire CDC.

The host Diocesan Secretariat/Movement should engage in prayer and request Palanca for the apostolic success of the Cursillo de Cursillos.
